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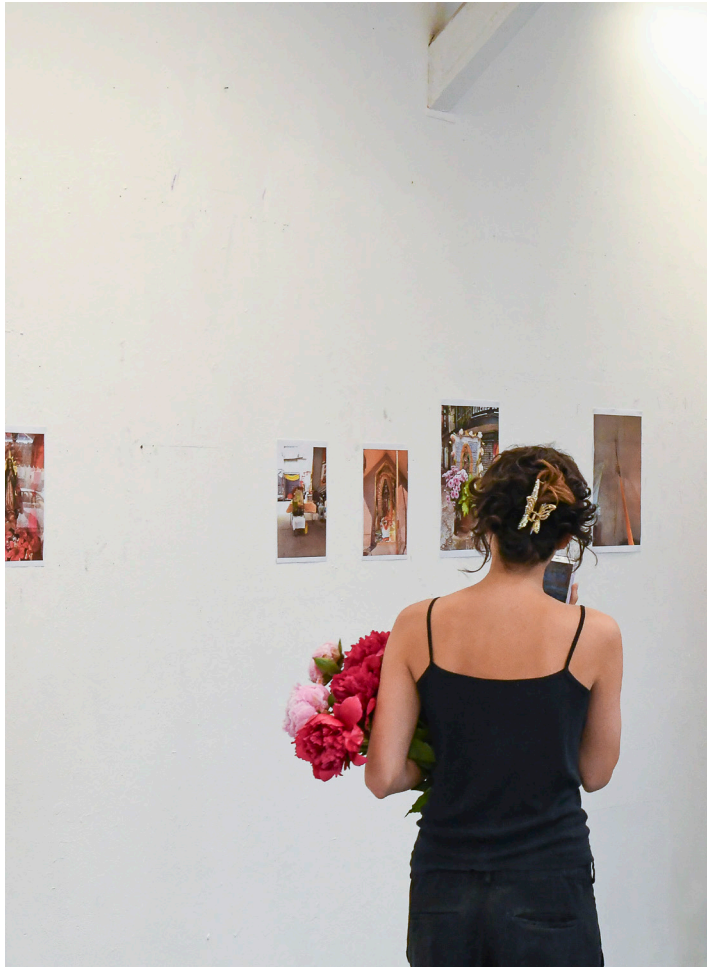

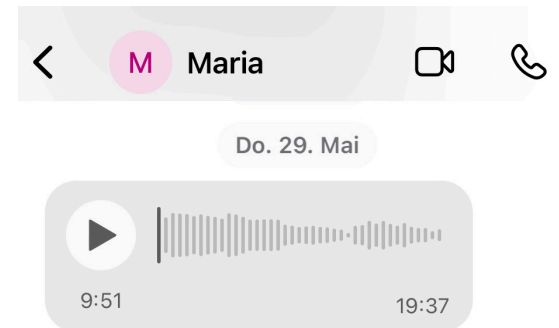

I get a jar of salt as a gift when I move into my flat, the label on the jar looks like the ones my grandma used to stick on her jam jars.

In a pack of sticky labels that I see in the drugstore, the labels have different pastel colours.

They are made of terry cloth, just like my grandma's towels my grandma used to have on a plastic towel rail on the green-tiled wall next to the washbasin.

The bar of soap that my grandma used to wash her hands and that she always put on the right edge of the sink next to the faucet was a different color and had a different smell than my grandpa's bar of soap.

I buy a bar of cream soap in a turquoise plastic soap box with dark blue lettering.

I look in fabric stores or needlework departments for pins with small round heads that are the same color as the soap box. They are called glass head pins.

In the dry cleaners where I drop off my winter jacket, it smells just like the room where my grandma used to wash the laundry for herself and my grandpa, dried and ironed.

I take the towels from the flea market to the dry cleaners and get a little light pink pick-up slip with the price for washing and drying written on it in blue ballpoint pen.

The little fasteners that my grandma bought in the department store, just like the darning thread, the needles and the sewing thread, are from the same brand as the silver pins that I bought last week.

My grandma gave me her sewing box, which always stood in her bedroom because she no longer sews.
